WHAT IS A RAC?

Resource Advisory Committees review projects submitted by agencies, non-profits, landowners, and others and make recommendations for funding. These projects must be on or adjacent to the Chugach National Forest. Types of projects include improving trails; soil productivity; ecosystem health; wildlife and fish habitat; native species or noxious weed control. The annual commitment is attending 2-3 one-hour admin meetings, a few hours to review proposals on your own time, and 1-2 day-long voting meetings.
